1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for modification in the order dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur, in FIR No.80 dated 23.03.2023 under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, vide which, while granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner, a condition was imposed that the accused shall surrender his passport before the Investigating Officer.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that the condition for surrender of the passport before the Investigating Officer has been imposed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur, while

granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, at the first instance, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to approach the concerned Court, which has imposed the aforesaid condition.
