This revision is accompanied by an application (CRM-878-2023) under Section 5 of the Limitation Act to condone the delay of 174 days in filing this revision petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length, but he could not convince this Court to justify the long delay of 174 days in filing the present revision petition. It is pertinent to mention that even before the Court of Sessions, appeal was filed with a delay of more than 02 years and 07 months. There is no justification for condoning the delay.
