Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to get re-conduct the survey of Lal Dora Abadi of Village Mandhana, Tehsil Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, as the half portion of the house of the petitioners has been illegally shown to be outside the Lal Dora and half portion in the Lal Dora, whereas the whole house of the petitioners is situated within Lal Dora since 1932.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievance, petitioners have filed representations before the respondents-authorities but no action has been taken on the same till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. She, on instructions from Mr. Rafliques ADA, Office of DC Mahendergarh, has submitted that the DC Mahendergarh has referred the application (Annexure P-10) to the BDPO but the competent authority to decide the objection is the Tehsildar. She

submits that if representation is filed before the Tehsildar, Narnaul, the same would be decided expeditiously.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation for the redressal of their grievance before the Tehsildar, Narnaul within a week from the date of receipt of copy of this order. If any such representation is filed, the Tehsildar concerned would decide the same expeditiously, preferably, within two months thereafter.
