1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to provide the deemed date reservation for promotion in Divyang Category to the post of JE-1 and all other promotion as per eligibility, in terms of Notifications dated 25.03.2022 (Annexure P-7), 01.07.2022 (Annexure P-8) and 11.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) issued by the Government of Haryana and Section 34 of RPWD Act dated 28.12.2016 (Annexure P-10) and with a further prayer for directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 27.01.2024 (Annexure P-11) of the petitioner in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a representation dated 27.01.2024 (Annexure P-11) to the Superintending Engineer/H.R., UHBVNL, Panchkula but the same has not been

considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the aforesaid representation dated 27.01.2024 (Annexure P-11) is considered and decided by respondent No.2-Superintending Engineer/Admn./, UHBVNL, Panchkula in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. He submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, he has no objection in case a time bound direction is issued by this Court in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintending Engineer/Admn./, UHBVNL, Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 27.01.2024 (Annexure P-11) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
