1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 09.03.2020 (Annexure P-5) passed by Ld. JMIC Barnala, whereby the application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. filed by the respondent/complainant for summoning Jagga Singh s/o Laxman Singh and Mahinder Singh, has been allowed in FIR No 18 dated 31.01.2016, under Sections 498-A/494 IPC registered at Police Station City Barnala.
