1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.4-District Registrar, Firms & Societies, Gurugram, to decide the complaints dated 27.05.2022, 10.06.2022, 05.07.2022 and 10.02.2023 preferred by the petitioner.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly contends that insofar as the complaints dated 27.05.2022 and 10.06.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-3) are concerned, the same have already been decided and now the grievance survives only with respect to the complaints dated 05.07.2022 and 10.02.2023 (Annexures P-4 and P-6), preferred by the petitioner. He further contends that he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.4 is directed to look into the aforesaid complaints dated 05.07.2022 and 10.02.2023 (Annexures P-4 and P-6) in a time bound manner, as one of the same is pending for nearly two years while the other is

pending for more than a year and to take an expeditious decision thereupon after affording opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Vivek Saini, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5. The present petition is accordingly **disposed of** at this stage without commenting on the merits of the case and with the consent of the parties, respondent No.4-District Registrar, Firms & Societies, Gurugram is directed to take an expeditious decision on the complaints dated 05.07.2022 and 10.02.2023 (Annexures P-4 and P-6) in a time bound manner and preferably within a period of 06 months from the next date of hearing fixed before him, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.
