This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 12.01.2023 passed in CWP-578-2023.

Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Counsel for the respondent submits that order dated 12.01.2023 passed in CWP-578-2023 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 23.08.2023 has been passed by the competent authority.
