This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.21, dated 17.02.2024 (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

In compliance of the order dated 07.05.2024 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court within a period of two weeks, for recording of their statements with regard to compromise. However, as per report dated 22.05.2024 of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, none of the parties had appeared for recording of their statements.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner as well as respondent No.2. It seems that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present petition. This Court has left with no other option but to dismiss the present petition.
