Petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P.4) passed by learned Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in CRA No.42 of 2023 titled "Parveen Goel Vs. DMC Shriram Limited", whereby bail earlier granted to the petitioner was withdrawn and bonds were forfeited to the State and presence of petitioner was directed to be sought through warrants of arrest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was earlier appearing regularly. On 24.01.2024 he could not appear due to some personal difficulty and his bail was cancelled on the very first date. Subsequently, fresh warrants of arrest have been directed to be issued on 28.03.2024 for 18.05.2024.

Without issuing any notice of motion to the opposite party, lest it may delay the proceedings, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the concerned Court on or before 30.4.2024. On his surrender, the Court will proceed against the petitioner under Section 446 Cr.P.C and after disposal of those proceedings, shall admit the petitioner to bail. However, it is made clear that till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime,

petitioner is sought to be arrested in view of the warrants of arrest issued against him, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
