1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to release the pending medical allowances and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) allowances, which are due towards respondent No.4 for more than one year along with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has produced copy of cheque No.405354 dated 23.05.2024 for Rs.25,000/- and submits that the same shall be deposited with the State Legal Services Authority, Punjab (costs as imposed vide order dated 13.01.2023) today itself. He further submits that all the dues of the petitioners have been released, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has not disputed the aforesaid factual aspect.

4. In view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
