The present petition has been filed under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for wilful and deliberate disobedience and non-compliance of order dated 09.11.2021 and 01.03.2023, passed by this Court in CRM M 43105-2021 and CRM M 10481-2023 respectively.
