1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners both of whom are major performed inter-faith marriage on 01.04.2024 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 11 who are extending threats to cause harm to the petitioners and in this regard representation dated 01.04.2024 Annexure P-5 is given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that before entering into wedlock, the petitioner No.1 converted from Hindu religion to Islam and to this effect affidavit Annexure P-4 of petitioner No.1 is placed on record.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider representation dated 2021 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.
5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
