Challenge in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to order dated 04.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana (in CrI. Revision No. 86, instituted on 19.05.2017) filed by the respondents against the order dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Sub Divisional Magistrate, Khanna (in MNT 125/03/15 titled as 'Surjit Kaur and another vs. Randhir Singh'), has been allowed.

The matter pertains to the year 2018. Perusal of the order sheets shows that notice in the present case was issued on 07.08.2018 and the matter was adjourned at the request of learned counsel for the petitioner on 27.07.2022. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last 2 dates of hearing i.e. 06.10.2023 and 02.04.2024. Today also, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Therefore, it can



safely be presumed that the petitioner or his counsel is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
