1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for taking strict legal action against respondent Nos.4 to 8 by registering the FIR under appropriate Sections of IPC and further directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to decide the representation dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law.
2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondents No. 4 to 8, the petitioner had moved the representation dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure P-1), but till date, no action thereon has been taken. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, Punjab, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

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4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
5. Heard.
6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, Punjab, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
