1. In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioners is that the petitioners were appointed during the pandemic of Covid but thereafter, the services of the petitioners were terminated and now, similarly situated employees have already been adjusted in the other department, which benefit has not been extended to the petitioners hence, such act on the part of respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioners by way of submitting the representations dated 04.05.2023 and 22.07.2023, copies of which have been attached as Annexure P-5 and Annexure P-6 respectively, and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representations.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representations dated 04.05.2023 and 22.07.2023 (Anneuxre P-5 and Annexure P-6 respectively) have been received from the petitioners and are still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioners as being claimed in those representations, the same will be extended to them otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioners, which will be conveyed to the petitioners.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
