PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Appellant as well as respondent-Darshan Kaur both have appeared in person and have produced copy of the written compromise. The same is taken on record as mark 'X'. Both the parties submit that the *lis* related to 08 marlas of land and as per the compromise, both have partitioned the same *inter se* between them i.e. appellant has come in possession of 04 marlas of land and the respondents have come in possession of the other 04 marlas. They thus submit that in view of their compromise, the present appeal be disposed off.

2. Since both the parties have submitted that the compromise already stands executed and performed, this Court does not deem it fit to draw the decree in terms of compromise. However, appeal is ordered to be disposed off in terms of compromise.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed off.
