MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 28 dated 01.09.2023, under Sections 21/29 of the NDPS Act (Sections 25/27-A of NDPS Act were added later on), registered at Police Station State Special Operations Cell, Amritsar, District Intelligent Wing (CID).
2. Vide order dated 23.05.2024, passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, in terms of the status report filed today in Court, has submitted that though the petitioner has joined investigation on 08.06.2024 but now she is in custody in connection with another FIR registered under the NDPS Act.
4. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.05.2024, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
