The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to her in case arising out of FIR No.104, dated 14.10.2020, under Sections 323,324,341,506,326,149,148,325 of IPC, Police Station Sadar Phagwara, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1).
