1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. prayer for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and for deciding his representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-9).

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions could be issued to respondent No.4-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-9) and take appropriate steps at the earliest to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Rana, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and 7 and 8, while Mr. Satya Pal Jain, Additional Solicitor General of India with Ms. Saigeeta Srivastava, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.6-Union of India.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.4-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-9) and take appropriate steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, if any, required, in accordance with law.
