SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J. (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court Under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been invoked seeking quashing of impugned order dated 07.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) with further prayer for grant of extension of parole to the petitioner till last breath beyond the period already granted vide order dated 19.01.2024 (Annexure P-3).
2. It has been contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the impugned order dated 07.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) has been passed by respondent No.3 in an illegal manner without appreciating the fact that the petitioner has been diagnosed with Carcinoma of Breast (Right) with Metswith HCV (+) and is taking Palliative Chemotherapy from Aadhar Health Institute. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record Under Treatment Certificate issued by Aadhar Health Institute, which is taken on record.
3. The petitioner vide order dated 19.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) had already been granted parole for 10 weeks which was further extended

till today i.e. 10.04.2024.

4. Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Baljinder Singh Virk, Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State, and does not controvert the aforesaid fact that adverting to the merits of the case and in light of the medical condition of the petitioner who is suffering from Carcinoma of Breast (Right) and is undergoing treatment from Aadhar Hospital, Hisar, the present application is allowed and the petitioner is granted parole w.e.f. 10.04.2024 till 10.07.2024.
