1. The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the learned Family Court, Karnal to decide the petition under Section 13(1) (ia) (ib) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing HMA No.488 of 2022, instituted on 02.05.2022 titled as Manoj Kumar Vs. Shalini Sadh (Annexure P-1), within some stipulated period.
2. When faced with this situation whether an application is moved by the petitioner in the trial Court to decide the divorce petition in a time bound manner, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would file such an application. She further submits that petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to the Ld. Family Court to decide the application in a time bound manner.
3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in the interest of justice, the petitioner is directed to file an application within 15 days for deciding the main petition in a time bound manner. In case such application is filed then same shall be decided by the concerned Family Court expeditiously but not later than three weeks thereof by passing a speaking order. It be ensured that no unnecessary adjournment is granted to any of the parties.
4. Petition stands disposed of.
