1. The petitioner has filed the present petition with a prayer to direct the official respondents to investigate the representation (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner to respondent No. 2.

2. On advance notice, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that a complaint has been received by the police against the present petitioner and the contents of the complaint are being examined by the police. He further contends that in case the cognizable offence is made out from the contents of the complaint, the police shall register the FIR and in case the police comes to the conclusion that no offence is made out, the matter shall be closed. Learned State counsel further assured the Court that the said exercise shall be completed within 03 days from today and petitioner will not be called by the police, without following the due process of law.

3. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further orders are required and the petition is accordingly disposed off.
4. Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail her alternative remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
