1. Present writ petition has been under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of petitioners w.e.f. 1996 and 2014 respectively and grant all consequential benefits.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that inadvertently, the objection of the reply dated 07.02.2024 (Annexure P-6) and objection of the reply dated 07.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) have not been challenged in the present writ petition and thus, he seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after laying challenge to the same.
3. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
