Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is Group-D employee working as Peon, who was transferred from Govt.Girls Senior Secondary School, Mandi Dabwali, to Govt.Girls Senior Secondary School, Sector 7, Panchkula, vide order dated 12.03.2024. Transfer order was subject to the availability of vacancy in the School at Panchkula. She was duly relieved from Mandi Dabwali but was not allowed to join by the concerned Principal at Panchkula for want of vacant posts. Her representation has also been rejected vide impugned order dated 29.03.2024, Annexure P-10, on the ground that in the absence of any vacancy in the School at Sector 7, Panchkula, she cannot be posted and is required to rejoin at the previous place of posting. It is further contended that the petitioner is a widow and had sought transfer either to Rohtak or Panchkula because at both the places her daughters reside with whom she would be able to live. In case there is no vacancy in the School at Sector 7, she can be considered against available vacancy in any other school at Panchkula, and she will

make appropriate representation to that effect to the concerned respondent.

3. Learned State counsel, appearing on advance notice, contends that in case any such representation is filed, the same shall be decided sympathetically, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receiving the representation.

3. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

4. Ordered accordingly.
