1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing for quashing the order dated 26.05.2004 (Annexure P-9) whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be reverted from the post of Draftsman to the post of Junior Draftsman.
