1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 31.10.2023 passed in CWP-21680-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Ravinder Kumar, Superintending Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation, Circle Faridkot, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 31.10.2023 passed in CWP-21680-2023 has since been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
