Petitioner is claiming Dearness Allowance @ 42% of basic pay in terms of office memorandum dated 01.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) issued by Government of India.
2.

The petitioner was an employee of State of Punjab.
3.

On being asked, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed his inability to show document disclosing that office memorandum dated 03.04.2023 issued by Government of India has been adopted by State of Punjab.
4.

In the absence of any document disclosing that State of Punjab has adopted aforesaid office memorandum, this Court cannot ask the State to pay Dearness Allowance @ 42% instead of 38%.
5.

The petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to avail remedies as permissible by law, if at any stage, he finds any document disclosing that State of Punjab has adopted aforesaid memorandum.
