1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3, who is acting at the behest of the private respondents.

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that he will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to decide his representation dated 29.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated time frame.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Amit Rana, Sr. Dy. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into the representation dated 29.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, expeditiously in accordance with law.
