1. The aforesaid petition was filed on 10.05.2021 by Shri Gurbir Singh Sidhu, Advocate. The Registry had raised objection on the case file on 10.05.2021.
2. As per Rule 9, Chapter 1, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by the counsel/ party, who filed it, to be re-filed within a total period of 40 days. In spite of SMS having been sent at the registered mobile, the same was not taken back for re-filing after removal of objections. On failure, the case is to be listed before the Court for orders.
