HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners, by way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seek issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to look into the complaint dated 16.06.2020 (Annexure P-5) made by them and direct the concerned authority to take action against private respondent Nos. 4 to 9.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the complaint / representation dated 16.06.2020 (P-5) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

[3] The above prayer seems to be justified.

[4] Learned State Counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

[5] In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this petition is **disposed off** with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the representation / complaint

dated 16.06.2020 (P-5) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of eight (08) weeks from today.
