RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 16.01.2024 passed in CWP-957-2024.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Ojasvi, Additional Chief Administrator, GLADA, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that the matter has been examined and necessary order has been passed qua the issue involved in the case of the petitioner. Since another Division Bench of this Court has already seized of the matter, therefore, by passing an order in the case of the petitioner, the matter has been kept in abeyance to await further orders from the Division Bench.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
