By way of present petition filed under Section 482 , petitioner prays for quashing the order dated 16.11.2023 (Annexure P.6), whereby the bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled and bonds were forfeited to State. Warrants of arrest were directed to be issued against her. Later on by way of the subsequent orders, Annexure P.7 and P.8, proclamation under Section 82 Cr.P.C. has been directed to be issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was regularly appearing during the hearing of Criminal Complaint bearing NACT No.2635 of 2020 titled “Anuradha Jaidka Vs. Sweety” in which she had been allowed bail. She could not appear on 16.11.2023 due to which her bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited to the State.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and that she be provided necessary protection.

Without issuing any notice to the respondents, lest it may delay the proceedings, this petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court concerned on or before 10.05.2024, the date already fixed thereat. On her surrender, the Court will proceed against the

petitioner under Section 446 Cr.P.C and after disposal of those proceedings, shall admit the petitioner to bail. However, it is made clear that till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested in view of the warrants of arrest/proclamation issued against her, she shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
