The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in case bearing FIR No. 164 dated 09.12.2006, under Sections 452, 326, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 & 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Hargobindpur, District Batala, Punjab.

[2] This Court, while issuing notice of motion vide order dated 08.04.2024, passed the following order:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the parties have already entered into settlement and petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the trial Court. Though, the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 10.03.2012, however, the operation of said order already stands stayed vide order dated 26.02.2024 passed in CRM-M-10043-2024.

Notice of motion for 15.05.2024.

Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear and surrender before the trial Court and on his appearance he shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing of adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner informs that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and furnished his bail bonds / surety bonds, besides getting his statement recorded in terms of compromise dated 30.01.2024 arrived at between the parties.

[4] In view of the above, the interim order dated 08.04.2024 passed by this Court is made absolute.
