1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for promotion to the post of Excise and Taxation Officer in accordance with instructions dated 17/19.04.2017 (P/-4) and thereafter, Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner from the date the employee junior to the petitioner namely, Anil Kumar was promoted hence, the respondents are liable to consider the claim of the petitioner for promotion on the post in question from the said date.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already approached the respondents by way of submitting representation dated 15.01.2024 (Annexure P/17), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case representation dated 15.01.2024 (Annexure P/17) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
