1. The Punjab Pollution Control Board has filed an affidavit, which *inter alia* reveals that on inspection made on 06.06.2024 and 12.08.2024, it was found that there are no pigs kept at the site, and all the remaining pigs have been sold; so as to prevent spread of disease in future. The piggery farm has been closed permanently.
2. In view of the above, the prayers in the writ petition stand redressed.
