1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 25.09.2023 passed in CWP-21418-2023.
2. Compliance affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 25.09.2023 passed in CWP-21418-2023 has since been complied with and representations of the petitioners have been decided by passing the speaking order dated 05.07.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
