Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though in the present petition, the charge-sheet dated 29.04.2021 (Annexure P-10) has been challenged but the pendency of the same is also causing prejudice to the petitioner and the respondents be directed to conclude the proceedings in respect of the charge-sheet dated 29.04.2021 (Annexure P-10) in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the proceedings qua the charge-sheet dated 29.04.2021 (Annexure P-10), if not already concluded, will be concluded within a period of four months

from the date of receipt of copy of this order in case, the petitioner cooperates.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to cooperate so as to conclude the proceedings within the time frame as suggested by the learned counsel for the respondents.

6. Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction that the proceedings qua the charge-sheet dated 29.04.2021 (Annexure P-10) be concluded within a period of four months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
