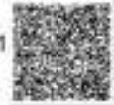

SANJIV BERRY, J. (ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 24.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the



petitioner may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 24.05.2024, the following order was passed:-

“In pursuance of the order dated 14.05.2024, the Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar is present in Court.

2. List on 15.07.2024.

3. After hearing and considering all the averments, in the interest of justice, it is deemed appropriate that the petitioner should join the investigation first before deciding the application on merits, accordingly, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 24.05.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 24.05.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will



influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
