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**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)**

1. By way of present appeal, challenge has been laid to an order dated 01.04.2024, passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, whereby the prayer made on behalf of the appellant seeking anticipatory bail, stood declined.

2. On 05.04.2024, this Court passed the following order:-

*“Learned counsel for the appellant inter alia submits that perusal of the entire FIR would show that no date or even the place of incident as alleged has been mentioned which raises suspicion about the facts stated in the impugned order.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Upon advance notice, Mr. Chetan Sharma, D.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State. Mr. Karan Singh, Advocate appears on behalf of private respondent*

No.2.

List on 10.04.2024.

*In the meanwhile, appellant will join investigation before the Investigating Officer as and when called. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to his satisfaction. The appellant is directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”*

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rameshwar submits that in compliance of orders dated 05.04.2024 and 10.04.2024, the appellant has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation as cancellation report has already been prepared by the investigating agency on 23.05.2024.

4. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the appeal is allowed. Order dated 05.04.2024 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.
