1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents No.2 & 3 to release the retiral benefits/dues to the petitioner along with interest and to grant the increment from the year 2008 onwards and also grant the benefit of 6th Pay Commission and also the benefit of LTC for the years 2008-11 and 2012-15.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had retired as Junior Accountant from the respondent-Bank on 31.12.2014 and till date his retiral benefits have not been released. He further submitted that a legal notice was issued by the petitioner to the respondent-Bank on 18.01.2024 vide Annexure P-12, but neither the legal notice has been replied to nor any action has been taken in this regard. He submitted that at this stage, the petitioner confines the scope of the present petition only to the extent that necessary direction may be issued to the

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respondent-Bank to consider and decide the legal notice (Annexure P-12) issued by him in accordance with law within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Singh Mann, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents and stated that he has no objection, in case, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 for considering and deciding the legal notice issued by the petitioner vide Annexure P-12 in accordance with law and within a time framework.
5. In view of the aforesaid position, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-The Registrar Co-operative Societies, Haryana to consider and decide the legal notice issued by the petitioner vide Annexure P-12 on 18.01.2024 strictly in accordance with law by passing a well-reasoned speaking order within a period of three months from today.
