The applicant-wife has filed the present application for seeking transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/427/2023, titled '*Raman Kumar Vs. Savita Devi*', filed at the instance of respondent-husband, pending in Family Court Panckula and she seeks transfer of the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

In pursuance of the notice issued, respondent has made appearance in person and to affix his identity, he has produced his Aadhar Card, copy whereof is retained on the record. He submits that he has no objection if the transfer application is accepted and the case is transferred from Family Court Panchkula, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that it is difficult for the applicant it is difficult for the applicant to defend the petition under



Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, at a distance of 160 kilometres, from the place of her residence, more particularly, when she is having the custody of the child, born from the wedlock of the parties to the lis.

Considering the same and also considering the statement given by the respondent, the instant application is hereby accepted and the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/427/2023, titled '*Raman Kumar Vs. Savita Devi*', filed at the instance of the respondent-husband, stands transferred from the Family Court Panchkula, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Nakodar, District Jalandhar. The requisite record of the aforesaid divorce petition shall be transferred by the Family Court Panchkula, to District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar.

Learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, shall assign the said petition to the Family Court (Camp Court) Nakodar. Even, the parties are directed to appear before the Family Court (Camp Court) Nakodar, within a period of one month from today onwards.
