1. The petitioner is seeking setting aside/cancellation of order dated 22.02.2023 passed by this Court (Annexure P-5) vide which respondents No.2 and 3 have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.184 dated 11.09.2021 under Sections 420/120-B of the IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

2. I have heard learned counsel at length and perused the relevant material on record.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has failed to bring to the notice of this Court any material from which it can be discerned that respondents No.2 and 3 had either misused the concession of bail granted to them vide order dated 22.02.2023 of this Court or had breached any conditions under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. Therefore, no ground is made out to cancel the order dated 22.02.2023 vide which respondents No.2 and 3 had been granted the

extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
