1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that she will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to decide her representation/complaint dated 12.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated time frame.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Amit Rana, Sr. Dy. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.4 – Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the representation dated 12.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law expeditiously.
