1. The petitioner has filed the present petition with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus in favour of the petitioner and to direct the official respondents to produce and release alleged detainee, namely, Rajwinder Singh.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Gurmeet Singh submits that the alleged detainee Rajwinder Singh has been arrested by the police in case FIR No. 46 dated 23.03.2022 under Sections 307, 323, 148 149 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Anaj Mandi, Patiala and he is being produced before the competent Court today. Learned State counsel further submits that following FIRs have been registered against the alleged detainee:-
 1. *FIR No. 76 dated 17.04.2022 under Sections 341, 308, 323, 379-B, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Tipri, District Patiala.*
 2. *FIR No. 91 dated 11.08.2023 under Sections 307, 325, 323, 336, 341, 279, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Anaj Mandi, Patiala.*

- 3. *FIR No. 119 dated 08.09.2023 under Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, Police Station Sadar, Patiala.*
- 4. *FIR No. 46 dated 23.03.2024 under Section 307, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Ananj Mandi, District Patiala.*
- 5. *FIR No. 139 dated 05.09.2022 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 325 and 34 IPC, Police Station Ananj Mandi, District Patiala.*

3. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail his alternative remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
