Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to issue directions to the respondent No. 3 on the application/complaint dated 05.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner to respondent No. 2 and to take legal action against respondents No. 4 to 7.

Learned State counsel at the very outset on instructions from ASI Jagmail Singh submits that as per the post mortem report, the cause of death in this case is given as ‘Cardiac Arrest’ and the Investigating Agency has concluded the investigation and found no evidence with regard to death of the brother of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents. Thereafter, on receipt of the FSL report, it was concluded that the cause of death is due to

heart ailment and no poision was detected by the Department of Pathology
GGS Medical College, Faridkot.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be
issued in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of accordingly.
