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AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5

The appeal stands settled at Rs.11,77,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of proposal form dated 24.01.2024 duly signed by both the parties.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.11,77,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lacs and Seventy Seven Thousand Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant No.1-Sukhdev Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 25.03.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

It is clarified that the whole amount is being paid to the appellant No.1. In view of the Power of Attorney circulated by the learned counsel for the appellants in favour of appellant No.1 to contest and do the needful in the matter. In view of that it is clarified that appellant No.2 onwards will not have any claim against the company and in case they have any objection, appellant No.1 undertakes to indemnify the rest of the appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
