This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of regular bail in case of FIR No. 20 dated 21.10.2023 under Sections 25 and 25(7) of Arms Act and Section 120-B IPC, registered at P.S. SSOC, District SAS Nagar Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no recovery has been effected from the conscious possession of the petitioner and investigation is complete. He further asserts that the case of the petitioner is at the same footing as the other co-accused -Hardeep Singh @ Dheer who has been granted the concession of regular bail vide order dated 11.03.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed in CRM-M-11720-2024 by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record. According to the custody certificate, the petitioner is behind the bars for the last 5 months and 24 days.

Considering the facts that no recovery has been effected from the possession of the petitioner, investigation is complete and the co-accused who is at same footing as the present petitioner, has been granted the concession of regular bail, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The present petition is, hereby, allowed.
