Learned State counsel submits that the Legal Notice, Annexure P-2, would be decided by the respondents/authorities expeditiously in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, i.e. Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, to decide the Legal Notice, Annexure P-2, dated 22.09.2018 expeditiously preferably within eight weeks from today.
