N.S.Shekhawat J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the official respondents No.2 to 5, not to involve the petitioner in some unsolved criminal cases.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely involved in two criminal cases i.e. FIR No.61 dated 04.02.2022, under Sections 457, 380 of IPC registered at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani and FIR No.225 dated 28.04.2022 under Section 379 of IPC, registered at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani and he is having apprehension that he might be falsely implicated in some other criminal cases.
3. On advance notice, Mr. Rajinder Kumar Banku, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that at this stage, the involvement of the petitioner has been found in both the above-mentioned cases and he was ordered to be arrested. However, the

petitioner has already been granted the concession of bail by the Competent Courts in both the cases. Learned State counsel further submits that the petitioner has not mentioned any reason as to why the police wants to involve him in false criminal cases and even otherwise, the apprehension expressed by the petitioner is unfounded.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. At this stage, there is nothing on record to suggest that the petitioner was falsely implicated in above-mentioned two cases nor the petitioner has been able to satisfy the Court with regard to his apprehension, as mentioned in the instant petition.

6. Thus, finding no merits, the present petition is ordered to be dismissed.
