1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the orders dated 25.07.2022 (Annexure P-15), dated 19.12.2023 (Annexure P-25) and dated 27.02.2024 (Annexure P-27).
2. Learned State Counsel has pointed out that against the impugned order, revision petition is maintainable whereas in para 16 of the present writ petition, it has been stated by the petitioner that there is no alternative remedy except to file the present petition and there is no remedy of revision or appeal etc.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to seek alternative remedy, in accordance with law.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
